Mark Flattery – (NETWORK 211) We have an amazing opportunity to partner with AGWM missionaries Nathan and Lisa Turney to plant a church just north of Auckland, New Zealand. This area is populated primarily with people from other Pacific Islands nations and so it is truly an international outreach. Here is how our partnership will work. Network211 will do a TEC (Targeted Evangelism Campaign) to focus our Google AdWord spend in nine specific and strategically chosen postal codes north of the city of Auckland. The idea is that individuals in these postal codes will Google their life issue, find a Network211 evangelism site and write to us. Nathan and Lisa will be the 1-2-1 Connector response team. This will be a “lead generator” for them as it will connect them with people in the community.

Bob & Michele Perez – (Latin America & the Caribbean) Greetings from Antigua. Last night we had the incredible privilege to minister to Cuban nationals on the island of Antigua. Here we have a great kingdom multiplication project run by our missionary friends Billy & Havila Roman.

Tim & Nicole Strange - (Costa Rica) The last several months have been full of ministry opportunities, teams working with us, & time with family. We are thankful for all who have come and invested their time & resources to work alongside us among the people of La Casona Territory. Special thanks to Duane & Tracie Corll & pastor Carol of Highway Tabernacle in Youngstown, OH who came in early January & held VBS's in 2 locations every day for the kids. We had over 40 kids plus adults in Alto Union Arriba, & over 80 kids in Pastor Ricauter's Church each day. Prayer Request: (1) Pray for continued growth spiritually of the group of believers in Alto Union Arriba & for an indigenous leader to be raised up and trained who will lead the group long-term. (2) Pray for God to lead us to more areas to plant churches on the La Casona Reserve and divine connections and favor to make inroads on the other 4 Guaymi reserves where we want to establish future ministry.



Sonia Alanya – (Spain) Currently, I'm living in NJ while I itinerate, which is the fundraising work of raising 100% of the proposed budget that will send me to my next, plant the church in Valencia, Spain. (1) Please pray for Irene, saved for 6 weeks, being disciple by the team in Valencia, learning to pray & read the bible, hungry for more but has many strongholds & participates in new age. (2) Pray for Ryan & Christy (ministry partners) that they continue to reach the many others as they take daily steps of faith. (3) Pray for God to stir the hearts of pastors & individuals and be led to give monthly. I'm starting a campaign to reach the \$1,000 in monthly commitments this month 75% so I can begin the visa process. Need ideas and strategy. For open doors of opportunity to share with churches, pastors, and individuals, open hearts to believe, open ears to hear the voice of God as he calls us to fulfill the great commission

Scott & Leah Schesser – (International Churches of Europe) After much prayer & seeking God, along with talking to both American & German church leadership, we have decided to land in Düsseldorf Germany. We will be helping Pastor Stefan Dahms at Kirche für Düsseldorf church located right in the city. Pastor Stefan wants to strengthen the church's ministry to English speakers. Düsseldorf is one of the most international cities in Germany, and many foreigners that live there can speak English, but not German. Prayer request: Please pray that God will provide the right apartment for us and our ministry here within our budget, which was originally set for a less expensive place to live. Also, Kirche für Düsseldorf has outgrown its space at its city campus & needs a new facility.
